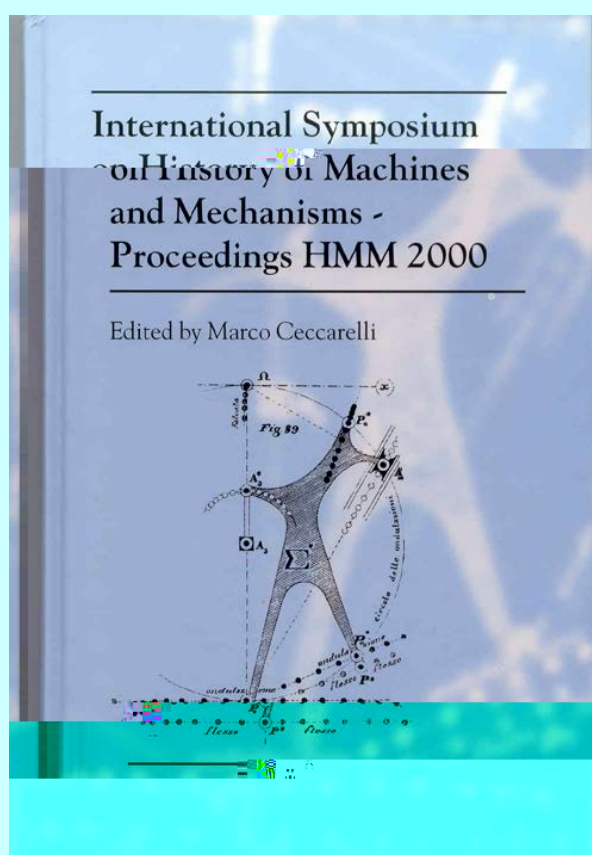
The HMM Symposium covers all aspects of development of MMS from Antiquity until the Present and its historiography as not only on:

- heritage of mechanical engineering

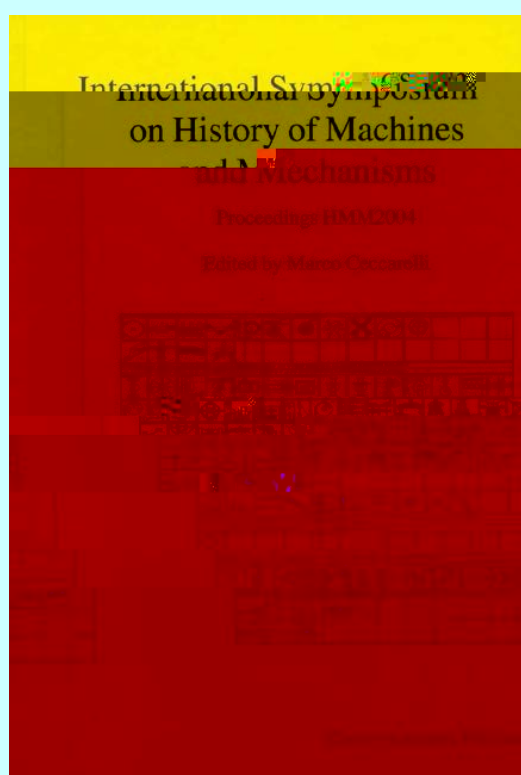
